

ROYAL GEORGE UPDATE - THEATRE CONSTRUCTION

Over the past few months we completed the geothermal drilling and the demolition of our properties on Victoria Street and have commenced work on the old Royal George itself.

We have received the final Site Plan approval and demolition permit from The Town. The recent judicial review unanimously confirmed The Town’s processes for approving the Royal George’s rebuild were thorough and the case has been dismissed, with Centurion required by both Courts to cover some of our and The Town’s costs.

Structural demolition of the old Royal George Theatre has now commenced and should be completed in June.

As we continue with demolition on the new Royal George site, we know that disruption is inherent to any such process. We are working diligently with our team to minimize disruptions where we can and maintain a safe and clean construction site and surround area. We thank you for your patience.

Upcoming Construction Milestones

Late May – late June	Demolition of the Royal George Theatre and Box Office buildings.
Late June	Final hoarding/fencing featuring an artful design will be installed around the perimeter of the construction site before shoring commences.

More interior plans for the new Royal George will be shared at an upcoming Community Update event. Timing and details will be announced in the coming weeks.
